

# UNAPPROVED MINUTES

## THE RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNING BODY CITY OF CHETOPA, KANSAS

June 23, 2017

The Chetopa City Council met in special session on Friday, June 23, 2017 at 7:00 p.m., at City Hall, for the specific purpose of discussion on repairs/replacement of city mower and to review applications to set up interviews for the city helper position.

PRESIDING: Mayor Terry G. Robison.

PRESENT: Council Members/Gary W. Bryant, Geraldine Castle, Betsy Koontz, Carthen Nash and Linda Seaman. Juanita Kepner was not present.

Mayor Robison called the meeting to order.

The Altoz mower broke down and the estimated repairs will cost \$1200. Bartlett Coop will check to see if the repairs will be covered under a warranty. Dugan looked into a lease of John Deere mowers at O'Malley in Pittsburg and the sales representative recommended purchasing the mowers and then trading them in every two years for new mowers.

Motion by Bryant, second by Koontz to proceed with fixing the Altoz mower. Motion carried.

Dugan was instructed to get prices on the John Deere, Altoz and Bad Boy mowers for next meeting.

Motion by Seaman, second by Koontz to enter into an executive session to discuss non-elected personnel with the mayor, council, city supervisor and clerk present for a period of 15 minutes with session ending at 8:11 p.m. Motion carried.
